Double Degree details

The program for social change makers

Gain the skills to address the major social challenges of our time, drawing on a strong ethical compass.

You'll gain the skills for diverse careers that address pressing social issues – such as poverty and inequality, racial injustice, health and illness, and the social impacts of climate change – at local, national and international levels.

Students will be enrolled in a 4 year program: Year 1 at CU, Years 2 and 3 at UQ, and your final year at CU. At the end of your studies you will receive both the CU Bachelor of Arts in Politics and Global Studies and the UQ Bachelor of Social Science (majoring in either Development or Social and Public Policy).

You'll gain a strong grounding in social justice, social research, and establish new links with community and industry, as well as create a strong foundation in the practice-based skills, values and knowledge needed to address key social problems. Practical and transferrable workforce skills include public policy evaluation, social impact assessment, public advocacy, community organising, community planning and social research.

Entry requirements

To be eligible to participate in this Double Degree program, Chula students must achieve:

- Average GPA of at least 2.0 (out of 4.0) upon completion of first year of study at CU
- IELTS overall 6.5, and no sub-band below 6.0 (other English Language Proficiency tests considered on a case-by-case basis)
